## Travels to Restricted Countries Bring Opportunity to Further Ministry

The past three months have been extremely busy...with making preparations to move my mom into a retirement center near my brother and sister, finishing up the 2,000 square foot addition to the warehouse for Phase II, and making preparations to depart for a three week missions trip to Bangladesh and India. For me, there is so much more to a trip than packing the right clothes; it's preparing the "seasoned" and relevant teachings and messages for the training sessions and ministry events on these trips.



I was so blessed to have a dear friend and prayer warrior, Sandra Mooring (pictured left), traveling with me to South Asia. She was a valuable asset to the effective and successful ministry that was done while there. Each day, her calling of intercessory prayer filled the morning with intercession and

worship.

It was an honor for us to travel to Bangladesh and work alongside Brenda Clowers and the medical team she took. In order for teams to get into these restricted countries, social ministry must be your pulpit. What a joy it was to minister to the precious people of Bangladesh through the wellness and vision clinic.



Traveling to restricted countries this year has been training time for me to meet the leadership and assess the discipleship training needs of the IPHC work. While in Bangladesh, I learned that in the last five years, they have established 22 house churches with over 300 members who have had

a life changing experience in meeting Jesus. However, they don't know how to pursue the deep revelation of who He is and why they have been chosen by Him.

Our work in India is huge, but of the billions living

there, only 10 percent are Christian (90 percent are of Islamic religion). I was told by our leadership in South India that the Christians and spiritual leaders have the same need as do those in Bangladesh, which is discipleship training.

## Focusing on the Next Five Years

So much was confirmed in my heart during my visit and ministry time in both these countries. Though it was very hard and very challenging, God met each of our needs and gave us strength to walk through each challenge with strong faith and courage. I wish to share more with you, but will have to come by your church or small groups to share in more detail. Thank you for keeping these precious brothers and sisters in restricted countries in your prayers and thoughts each day. The power of prayer and the Word does truly push back the evil work of Satan and gives light and life to a dark and sinful life. I believe the Lord has quickened my heart with an overwhelming burden for the persecuted church in the restricted countries, and I also believe God is calling some of you who are in pastoral/church leadership. Be a part of an OTT training team and go with me to bring strength, encouragement, and discipleship training to our brothers and sisters who face danger and death on a daily basis because of their decision to live for Jesus Christ.

While fulfilling the next five year focus on the 10/40 window, we also are involved in trying to reach the most unreached people group in America, the Native Americans. In just a few days of this writing, a team of nine will be leaving for the Navaho Reservation in Arizona, and at the end of the summer, to Fairbanks, Alaska for ministry and training.

It is impossible to express in words my deep appreciation for all that you do to make this ministry happen; your prayers, your giving, and your recycled resources. We continue to ship and courier resources all over the world. Our partnership is making a tremendous difference in lives of people you will never meet until we get to Heaven! Keep up the good work, because you can count on me to keep it up too! Love and prayers remain with you always.
